For our FQHC/Community Health/Non-Profit clients, we offer a solution to ensure your patients are not subjected to excessive out of pocket expense based on financial review and qualifications meeting poverty guidelines of 300%. This allows for HealthTrackRx's charity write-off of 100% patient liability. Our HealthTrackRx Financial Assistance program is administered on an annual basis, January through December.

As part of this agreement, we want to ensure a great experience for both our clients and patients. Based on your facility's enrollment into the program, you agree that any patients submitted for the HealthTrackRx Financial Assistance Program have met all standards for poverty guidelines. We will not subject you to any upfront paperwork in order to prevent delays in testing. We aim to provide you with results to align with your approach to meeting the care and needs of your patients.

Based on this agreement, you also understand that HealthTrackRx will conduct a quarterly audit of a subset of your patients referred into the program. You agree to provide proof of patient eligibility into the HealthTrackRx Financial Assistance Program. Based on the audit outcome, if we identify any patients who fail to meet the proper guidelines, we will bill the patients for cost sharing expenses as deemed appropriate by the patients' health plan.
