

HealthTrackRx first partnered with UPS Healthcare for a pilot project in 2022, matching our diagnostic capabilities with UPS' robust logistics to successfully deliver overnight test results to patients. Now, by co-locating our newest campus within the UPS Healthcare Labport in Louisville, HealthTrackRx can expand that impact and receive overnight specimen deliveries starting at 1 a.m., allowing for overnight processing and next-morning results to clinics across the country.

This innovative model has transformed infection diagnosis and treatment for thousands of providers. With HealthTrackRx, care decisions are faster, more precise, and evidence-based — improving outcomes, reducing unnecessary antibiotic use, and lowering overall healthcare costs. No more guesswork. No more decades-old methods.
